Agenda Item Description:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires entitlement communities to submit an Annual Action Plan as the official application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding. The [plan](#) establishes the City's strategic and production goals for the program year. Development of the FY2026-27 plan included a multi-phase public engagement process including public hearings and meetings, comment period, and a community survey and has been revised to reflect comments received during the public hearings.

Recommended Action: Adopt the Annual Action Plan for fiscal year 2026-2027 and authorize staff to submit the plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Authorize the Mayor to execute the transmittal letter, certifications, and related documents.

Agenda Item Details:

Every year, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires communities receiving federal funding through its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs to submit an Annual Action Plan. The plan serves as the City's application for entitlement funding and provides a framework for strategic and production goals.

Development of the FY2026-2027 Annual Action Plan included a multi-phase public engagement process conducted in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan. Outreach efforts included two public hearings, public meetings, and a community survey designed to gather input from residents and stakeholders on housing and community development needs.

The first public hearing was held December 2, 2025, after which staff drafted the Annual Action Plan and released it for a 30-day public comment period. The second public

hearing was held April 7, 2026, to receive comment on the draft plan. A summary of all public comments received throughout the planning and adoption process is included in the final Action Plan.

The Action Plan is available on the City [website](#) and has been revised to reflect the comments received during the second public hearing. All public comments received will be included in the final plan submitted to HUD.
